New Business

Re: Collection of Compost – County of Annapolis

On September 6th, the Municipality of the County of Annapolis served an Immediate Order on Valley Waste to have the Valley Waste compost bins emptied of compostable waste to alleviate health and safety concerns. The VWRM Authority does not agree with the Order.

Through discussion between the CAO and the Interim Manager of Valley Waste Cathie Osborne, Valley Waste is willing to lift the order they placed on EFR to not touch the Valley Waste bins, so that compost can be removed and green carts picked up by VWRM at a future date.

Councillor Heming moved, seconded by Councillor Gunn that Municipal Council approve the following strategy for the resolution of the public health risk to County residents posed by organic waste: Request that Valley Waste immediately remove the restriction placed on EFR to empty compost bins; request that Valley Waste collect the bins as soon as possible and to be completed not later than October 31, 2018; and that Municipal Council agrees to cover the cost of collection and disposal of compost from the green carts. Motion carried unanimously.
