Section Procedures and Organization of Council	Subject Declaration of Proclamations

- **APPLICATION**
This policy applies within the Municipality of the County of Annapolis.
- **AUTHORITY**
Sections 2 and 47(1) & (2), *Municipal Government Act*
- **POLICY INTENT**
To officially declare proclamations either initiated by the Municipality or are copasetic with activities sponsored by the Municipality.
- **PURPOSE**
Whereas the Municipality promotes activities for: celebrating various cultures, encouraging active living and health, condemning violence, acknowledging volunteers and seniors, and recommending protection of the environment; the declaration of proclamations relating to such promotions would be appropriate. The listing of proclamations specified in Section 5 can be amended by resolution of Council.
