

## ***MI SEAL BYLAW***

1. The following device and inscription, viz.:

*A ship, together with a sheaf of wheat and sickle, representing Commerce and Agriculture, in the centre, encircled with the words, "Municipality of Annapolis, N.S. Inc. 42 Vic. Chap. 1, 1879", the same to be engraved on metal two inches in diameter, shall be the seal of the Municipality of Annapolis.*

2. The Seal may be used on official municipal documents, including, but not limited to: contracts and agreements signed by the Warden, Chief Administrative Officer and/or Municipal Clerk on behalf of the Municipality.
3. The Seal shall not be reproduced in graphic format for use as a "logo" of the Municipality.
