BEGINNING at a survey marker set on the East sideline of the Purdy Road, a distance of 699.44' at a bearing of North 17 degrees 39' 57" West from Nova Scotia Control Monument 15225;

THENCE North 47 degrees 44' 26" West a chord distance of 173.93' along an arc a distance of 175.46' having a radius of 383.130' to a survey marker set;

THENCE North 73 degrees 39' 13" East a distance of 141.50' to a survey marker set;

THENCE South 35 degrees 58' 01" East a distance of 104.63' to a survey marker found;

THENCE South 35 degrees 58' 01" East a distance of 11.31' to a survey marker found;

THENCE South 50 degrees 02' 33" West a distance of 98.03' to a survey marker set being the PLACE OF BEGINNING.

TOGETHER WITH a right of way over lands reserved to Frederick E. Purdy, said right of way being two and one half rods in width and lying between the lands above described and the lands described as being owned and occupied by one James Johnston.
