GRANVILLE FERRY WATER USERS IN GRANVILLE FERRY

Due to water quality problems and the possibility of unsafe water, consumers are advised NOT to use their water for drinking, preparing infant formulas, preparing juices and ice cubes, washing fruits and vegetables, cooking, dental hygiene or any other activity requiring human consumption. Boiling will not remove contaminant. **This is to be done until further notice.**

REPAIR AND TESTING OF WATER QUALITY

Repairs to the reservoir are now complete and water is now in the tank. During the testing phase of water quality and to assist with flushing the waterlines within your homes, please run your taps and / or hoses for 5 minutes. Please be reminded that this does not allow you to consume the water.

DRINKING WATER

The County of Annapolis will supply drinking water to residents affected by the Advisory until further notice. Water may be picked up at the Annapolis Royal Fire Depart daily from 10 am to 4pm. Please access fire hall from Fortier Mills Lane to avoid front parking lot.
